BILLS OF COSTS

1. In order to achieve uniformity in the format of bills of cost and to expedite taxations every bill of costs lodged for taxation must conform as nearly as possible, having regard to the circumstances of any particular case, to the specimen bills of costs copies of which may be obtained from the Taxing Office.
2. In the rare case where it appears to be impossible to comply with paragraph 1 hereof the direction of the Master must be sought.
3. The staff of the Office will not accept for taxation any bill of costs which does not comply with this direction without the leave of the Master.
4. This Direction shall come into force on 1st February 1989.
