**PRACTICE DIRECTION No 01 OF 2014**

**Service Fees in Relation to Conditional Orders for Issue of Warrant of Arrest and Attendance Orders**

1. This practice direction should be read in conjunction with:
  - a. Article 27(2) of the Judgments Enforcement (NI) Order 1981;
  - b. Article 126 of the Judgments Enforcement (NI) Order 1981;
  - c. Rule 18, 19 & 20 of the Judgments Enforcement Rules (NI) 1981;
  - d. Rule 75(1) of the Judgments Enforcement Rules (NI) 1981;
  - e. Rule 78 of the Judgments Enforcement Rules (NI) 1981and;
  - f. Rule 106 of the Judgments Enforcement Rules (NI) 1981.
  
2. Where a creditor in the course of service (or attempted) service of a conditional order for issue of warrant of arrest or attendance order incurs costs, the amount that shall be allowed as reasonable costs to be recovered from the debtor shall be set at £30.00.
  
3. This cost shall be added to the amount recoverable under the judgment so long as either:
  - a. valid proof of service of the conditional order, or attendance order, or;
  - b. valid proof of attempted service of the conditional order, or attendance orderis provided to the Enforcement of Judgments Office.
  
4. This amount is being allowed under Rule 106 of the Judgements Enforcements Rules (Northern Ireland) 1981 and in addition to Schedule 2 thereto.
